Want ASE Certification?

Currently, about 400,000 professionals hold ASE certifications. ASE certification occurs when a prospective candidate passes one or more of ASE's 40-plus exams and provides proof of two or more years of relevant full-time hands-on work experience. The tests are divided into specialties such as: automobile, medium/heavy truck, truck equipment, school bus, collision repair technicians, engine machinists, alternate fuels technicians, parts specialists, auto service consultants, and collision damage estimators.

Paper/Pencil tests are conducted twice a year; however, you must register well in advance and pay your registration fee of \$32. Active Duty, Reserve and Guard personnel are eligible for the **three funded ASE tests ONLY AT the DANTEs Test Sites.**

DANTEs does not fund L1, L2, and the recertification tests. All regular tests except L1 and L2 are \$27.00 each. L1 and L2 are \$54.00 each.

With your Registration Form, examinees must provide payment for:

- the registration fee of \$32.00,
- any additional regular tests at \$27.00 each,
- L1, and/or L2 at \$54.00 each, and
- recertification tests (if applicable)
