

1. In accordance with the reference, an unannounced MDI of MCAS Yuma's CYTP was conducted between 14 October and 11 November 2015. Inspected areas were Resource and Referral (R&R), Child Development Center (CDC), School Age Care (SAC), Family Child Care (FCC) and Youth and Teen (Y&T).

2. Final inspection grade is 99.6%. Of the 256 requirements inspected; (0) were non-compliant, (1) was partial compliant, 252 were fully compliant and (3) were not applicable. The following is a summary of the one noted discrepancy.

- a. Early Childhood Education. (Administrative I.B.1) Program participant - CDC files: During a spot check of children's emergency contacts, 1 child had 2 of 3 required emergency contacts filled out. Original 3 contacts were crossed out. Administrative clerk then pulled sibling's file to determine emergency contact information. Note made by clerk to contact parent and update emergency point of contact phone numbers.

3. Corrective action for the above discrepancy will be addressed by the CYTP administrator. Overall, the MCAS Yuma CYTP is being managed and operated with absolute professionalism and a high regard for the safety and health of all children under its care.


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
