

Subj: RESPONSE TO MARINE CORPS AIR STATION YUMA DRUG DEMAND REDUCTION PROGRAM REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

1. Purpose. To provide urinalysis data, including total number tested and total "wrongful use" positives, for Total Force and Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Yuma for fiscal year (FY) 2017.

2. Key Points

- Data include the most recently approved Headquarters Marine Corps Behavioral Health total tested and positive urinalysis counts.
- Data are from 01 Oct 16 through 30 Sep 17 as of 04 Oct 17. Any samples processed after 04 Oct 17 are not included in this report.
- All data reported include any Service member tested under a Marine Corps reporting unit code (RUC).
- For purposes of this report, data are not unique, and total numbers are reported. Therefore, these data may contain multiple results for the same Service members over time.
- The initial data request included the following requested data points:
  - o Total number of samples submitted and tested at the lab
  - o Total number of drug positives
  - o Top five illicit drug positives and number of positives for each
  - o A comparison of the data points above between MCAS Yuma and Total Force
