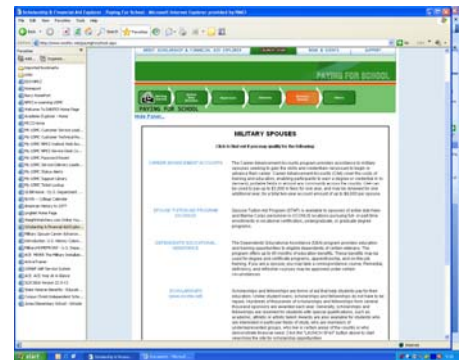
Academic Explorer (AeX), Scholarship and Financial Aid Explorer (SFeX), Integrated Explorer (IeX) and Job Explorer (JeX)

There are four different search options located at the top and bottom of the home page of www.mcaex.net. The first option is the Academic Explorer (AeX), which is "a powerful web-based tool for identifying and exploring post-secondary education options in an un-biased, standardized, and comprehensive manner."

A second option is the Military Community Scholarship and Financial Aid Explorer (SFeX), which allows you to view scholarships and financial aid opportunities. In addition, you can click on the "paying for school" link to search for the many options to pay for school.



A third options is the Job Explorer (JeX), which lists job opportunities for transitioning Service Members and their families.

A fourth option is (IeX), which is an integrated search for AeX, SFeX and JeX that allows you to view Certificate/Degree Programs, related Scholarships and pertinent jobs.
